Glimpses from the India Bird Races - Gujarat 2023

Last year, 52 teams from all over the Gujarat contributed their efforts in conserving birds with and without remuneration. The event was generously sponsored and supported by HSBC, the Yuhina Canopy, India Bird Races, BCSG, and eminent birders. Together, 343 species were identified during the day-long Bird Race event

covering birding locations in 30 districts of Gujarat. Some fortunate teams found Redthroated pipit and Greater white-fronted goose which were unique sightings. Teams, opted for remuneration, were provided Rs 2000/- per team to meet their travel expenses. Multiple eBird checklists by each team were submitted during the full day event.

❖ About India Bird Races - Gujarat

India Bird Races, sponsored by HSBC and co-sponsored by Sebamed, have become the largest and most popular bird watching activity across the country. In Gujarat, Bird Conservation Society, Gujarat (BCSG), established in 2000, coordinates this event with their state wide network of expert birders.

- Each team (BUT up to a maximum of 38 teams) receives a suitable honorarium towards incidental expenses. Paid incentive is Rs 2000/- per team, provided that they include at least one area from the provided list of locations. Incentive priority will be given to the university students and local team of that area.
- Each team can indicate 3 areas of their preference. Allotment of the area are done by BCSG if there are more teams having the same area's preference.
- All the teams are required to submit their eBird checklists from their own account.
- Teams, who do not opt for incentives, can also participate and submit data voluntarily. They are free to choose any location within Gujarat. For incentives, refer areas in the section, **List of Birding Sites as Preference**.
- It is mandatory that you have to select the birding area from the given list in the Google form. You can suggest other nearby hotspot areas.
- During the survey **diversity of bird species** is more important. Population estimation/count is not a priority.
- The event includes a social meet followed by dinner on January 7 (Sunday), 2024. Meet and dinner happen in or nearby Ahmedabad. The exact venue gets informed near to the event date.

Guidelines to participate in India Bird Races – Gujarat 2024

Each participant must follow the below guidelines to participate in India Bird Races - Gujarat 2024.

- Each participant is required to submit the Google form before the last date of registration. Google form link is provided at the end of this document.
- Each team should consist 3-5 persons (not more than 5 persons). They are free to create their own team but must ensure at least one of them is a proficient birder, familiar with the region's birdlife, and must have an eBird account.
- There is no registration fee for any of the India Bird Races.
- Each team should remain as a single unit for the entire race, walk, trek, dive or drive or even fly as much as you may to a site or a cluster of sites.
- This Bird Race is a **full day event**.

- Each team must submit their checklists on eBird. Then share them with team members and tag **BCSGBIRDCOUNT** and email checklist to birdcsg@gmail.com
- Only after submitting the total checklists of the birds, the payment procedure will occur.
